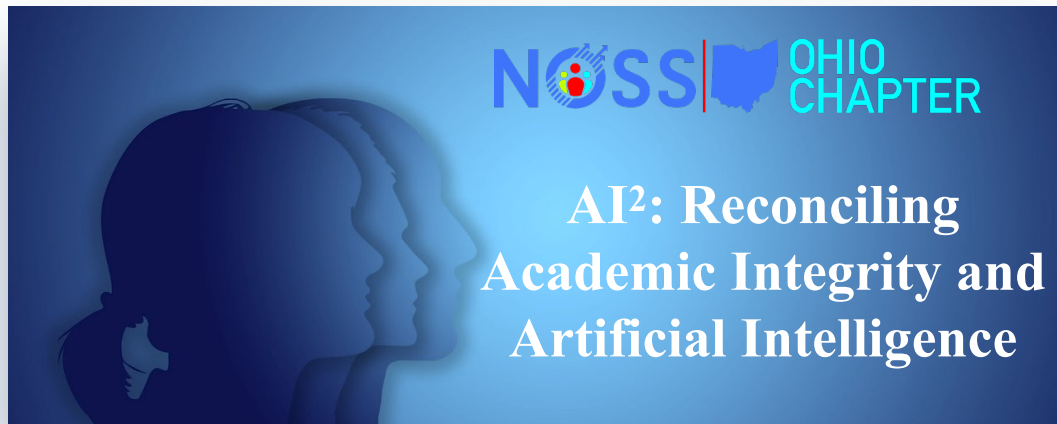




NOSS: OH 2024 Annual Conference

As a student support professional, how have you incorporated the use of **artificial intelligence** into your workflow?

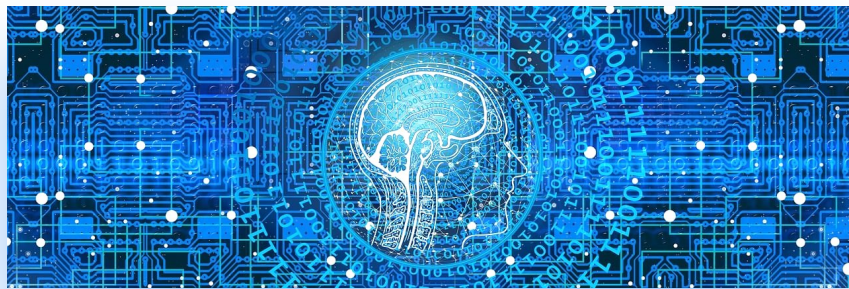


Proposal submission is now open for 50-minute concurrent session presentations in one of two formats:

3. Presentation Type: Virtual OR In-Person
4. Presentation Title [10 words or less]
5. 100-word presentation description/abstract that clearly connects presentation to the conference theme.
6. Three specific outcomes [i.e. After this session, attendees will be able to...]
